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Terra Madre Salone del Gusto fair will take place in the grand historic piazzas of Turin's city center. At the heart of it all will be the magnificent Terra Madre Salone del Gusto Market, featuring over 700 producers from Italy and around the world who have made the protection of biodiversity and the promotion of their local areas the hallmark of their work. The entrance to Terra Madre Salone del Gusto 2024 is free! You will need to purchase tickets for paid events such as Taste Workshops and Dinner Dates (you can buy tickets for these events on this site), and any other events labelled "paid" purchasable on external platforms, but you do not need a ticket to enter Terra Madre.
